




Crayons Quick Baby Quilt



36 x 45 inches

- 5 different fabrics - cut $9 \frac{1}{2}$ inches x width of fabric (number & label your fabrics 1-5)
 - From Fabrics 1, 2, 3 and 5
 - Cut 2 - $9 \frac{1}{2}$ inches x $18 \frac{1}{2}$ inches strips fabrics 1, 2,3 and 5
 - From Fabric 4
 - Cut 1 – $9 \frac{1}{2}$ inches x $18 \frac{1}{2}$ inches strip
 - Cut 2 - 5 x $18 \frac{1}{2}$ inch strips
 - Cut 2 – 5 inch squares from each of the five fabrics
 - Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on each 5 inch square

Following diagram below:



- Attach 5 inch square to one end of each 9 ½ inch x 18 ½ inch strip and sew on diagonal line from bottom outside corner to top center.
- Trim ¼ inch on outside of stitch line and press
- Attach next five inch square to opposite side of strip end
 - Repeat to make a total of 5 - 9 ½ inch x 18 ½ inch blocks.Sew blocks together to make an 18 ½ inch x 45 inch column
- Sew remaining strips together to make an 18 ½ inch column.
 - Start and end with the 5 x 18 ½ inch fabric #4 strip.
 - Sew the 2 columns together matching colors
